Ruby Blair made a motion, seconded by Gen Gearing, that minutes of the April 21, 2010 meeting be approved. The motion passed.

Ashley Buehler was present to represent MERS Goodwill at **102 W. 9<sup>th</sup> St.** She presented plans to install an aluminum 2' x 8' sign with a vinyl adhesive over the aluminum. The sign will have a white background, black letter and the Goodwill logo that has blue, black and white colors. It will be mounted flush with the building over the door. Mark Wuellner made a motion, seconded by Mike Doucleff that said sign be approved as presented.

Jerry Wunderlich was present to represent Stifel Nicolaus at **121 Market St.** He presented plans to install an internally lit aluminum sign that will be 3-1/2' by 2- 7/8'. The panel will be black with clear acrylic letters pushed through for the name and silver and bright blue Metallic painted underneath that. He will also be installing a lighted reader board directly beneath this sign that will be roughly 6" high and 3-1/2' long. There will also be black vinyl lettering on the door identifying the business. Gen Gearing made a motion, seconded by Margaret Hopkins, that plans for the Stifel Nicolaus sign, the reader board to go underneath the sign and the vinyl signage of the door be approved as presented. The motion passed.
