

MINUTES OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING OF THE HISTORICAL COMMISSION

The sub-committee meeting of the Historical Commission was called to order by Chairman Bader on Tuesday, April 7, 2009, at 8:10 a.m.

The sub-committee of the commission took up the application for **614 E 4th St.**, presented by Kenny D. Matlock for a 6-foot chain link fence which will be entirely in the back yard. After discussion, the application was approved by the sub-committee on a motion made by Mary Anderson, seconded by George Carter. Motion passed unanimously.

The sub-committee of the commission discussed having a meeting on April 8, 2009, at 8:00 a.m., to take up the applications on **301 Prospect** and **418 Ridge**. Secretary will coordinate and advise members.

The sub-committee of the commission discussed the application for **301 Prospect**, presented by Larry Powers and Burce Grenzebach (Grenzebach & Son Construction) for a deck addition. Mr. Powers might also be replacing windows at a later date, and will get on the agenda. The application for the deck extension will be taken up at the meeting on April 8, 2009.

The sub-committee of the commission discussed the application for **418 Ridge** for demolition. The application will be taken up at the meeting on April 8, 2009.

Chairman Bader advised that he would like for all nominations for the awards to be in by the April 21, 2009, meeting, with voting being done at the May 5, 2009, meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:45 a.m.
