

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE HISTORICAL COMMISSION**

The meeting of the Historical Commission was called to order by Chairman Bader on Tuesday, October 6, 2009, at 8:00 a.m.

The minutes of the September 15, 2009, meeting were approved on a motion made by Kerry Miller, seconded by Mary Anderson.

The commission took up the application on **703 Henry**, presented by Jeff Bock of United Contractors, for canopy rehab. The chains will be removed from the roof to the canopy, with some re-roofing and seamless gutters. The poles will be replaced with round fluted columns. After discussion, the application was approved on a motion made by Kerry Miller, seconded by Mary Anderson. Motion passed unanimously.

The commission took up the application on **313-315 E 3<sup>rd</sup>**, presented by Marilyn Tohill, for the two front gables and dormer to be covered in cedar fishscale, with the fans and soffit to be painted; a motion was made to amend the application. After discussion, the application was approved on a motion made by Ray Strebel, seconded by Mary Anderson. Motion passed unanimously.

The commission took up the application on **536 E 6<sup>th</sup>**, presented by Bruce Robinson, for window replacement and to cover one (1) bedroom window and door on porch. After discussion, the application was approved on a motion made by Mary Anderson, seconded by Kerry Miller. Motion passed unanimously.

The commission took up the application on **618 E 16<sup>th</sup>**, presented by Carl Ericson, for a one-car garage. There will be access from the alley, with vinyl siding to match the house. After discussion, the application was approved on a motion made by Kerry Miller, seconded by Mary Anderson. Motion passed unanimously.

The next meeting of the historical commission will be on Tuesday, October 20, 2009, at 7:00 p.m., in Council Chambers at Alton City Hall.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:50 a.m.
